

6 Principles of adding new trade divisions

1. The works in the trade division fall within the definition of “Construction Work” of the Construction Workers Registration Ordinance.
2. The scope of works in the trade division can be clearly defined and described.
3. The whole scope of works in the trade division is not part of the description of work specified in the existing designated trade divisions (not applicable to the cases of adding “Registered Semi-Skilled Worker” to the existing designated trade divisions).
4. There is a workmanship level of the trade division recognized by the industry and the level can be clearly established and assessed.
5. The workmanship level of the trade division will affect the quality of the operation.
6. Trade training / test body(ies) can establish an assessment system to assess the skill level for the trade division.
