4.2 Matters Arising from the Previous Meeting

The CIC Secretariat updated Members on the following matters:

<u>Item 3.3 – Final Report on CIC R&D Fund Project – Smart Design</u> <u>and Development of a Vent Protector (SVP)</u>

Final payment has been released. The SVP information has been uploaded to CITAC website and the SVP is exhibiting at CITAC. The CIC Secretariat provided support for the CITF application. It is now awaiting Samson Wong Association Limited to submit the application.

<u>Item 3.4 – Progress Update on CIC R&D Fund Project – iBEAM Unison</u>

The first stage payment has been released to BEAM Society Limited (BSL)

Item 3.6 – CIC Sustainable Finance Certification Scheme (SFCS)

The working group has been reactivated, the first meeting after reactivation has been arranged on 11 November 2022 to discuss the development of the scheme.

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<u>Item 3.7 – Progress Update on Smart Waste Management (SWM)</u>

DEVB has lined up CEDD to provide opinion on the development of SWM, the beta version of SWM Tool will be showcased at CIExpo to be held on 13-17 December 2022.

Others – CIC Carbon Assessment Tool (CAT)

The quotation exercise for the consultancy service to provide preliminary studies, IT functions upgrade and O&M services for CAT is completed. It is expected that a consultant will be appointed in early December 2022 to provide the service.

4.3 Progress Update on the Consultancy Services on Development of Strategy and Plan Directional Guideline for the Hong Kong Construction Industry Achieving Carbon Neutrality Target according to the Hong Kong's Climate Action Plan 2050

Members were briefed on the Inception Report stating the approach and action plan for the consultancy.

Members recommended to involve industry associations, experts in academic sector and non-government organisations at an early stage to ensure the deliverables are well received by the industry stakeholders.

Members suggested to conduct more research on overseas CECEP experience in the study. Members sought clarifications on the life cycle assessment approach. It was clarified that to tie in with international approach, a life cycle perspective will be adopted. However, the CIC will focus on the measures suitable for the local CIC market. The study shall consider and look into local policies, supply Secretariat chain, and particular areas where effective measures can be implemented to contribute towards carbon neutrality. For example,

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during the operation stage, the CIC may concentrate on the maintenance and RMAA instead of the operation issues.

Members approved the Paper CIC/ENV/P/019/22 including the Inception Report and the release of the stage payment to CECEP.
