The selection criteria for CIOYPA are the (1) personal achievements; (2) contributions to the construction industry; (3) contributions to the society; (4) commitments to future Hong Kong; and (5) experience and visions. The nominees are nominated by a proposer and required to attend an initial screening interview conducted by the Selection Consultant of CIOYPA, PricewaterhouseCoopers Limited. The shortlisted nominees are required to attend the final judging interview chaired by Hon. Abraham SHEK, Legislative Council Member (Real Estate and Construction), and with members included Ir LAM Sai-hung, Permanent Secretary for Development Works, Hon. WONG Kwok-kin, Non-official Member of the Executive Council, and Mr. CHAN Ka-kui, Chairman of the CIC.



## About the Construction Industry Council

The Construction Industry Council (CIC) was formed in 2007 under the Construction Industry Council Ordinance (Cap. 587). The CIC consists of a chairman and 24 members representing various sectors of the industry including employers, professionals, academics, contractors, workers, independent persons and Government officials.

The main functions of the CIC are to forge consensus on long-term strategic issues, convey the industry's needs and aspirations to the Government, provide professional training and registration services, and serve as a communication channel between the Government and the construction industry.
