Industrial accident

A fatal accident happened on 13 May 2020, in which a worker fell through a structure inside a plant room to the railway below at MTR Hong Kong Station in Central.

Recommendations

As a Contractor / Subcontractor / Employer:

- 1. Appoint a competent person to conduct task-specific risk assessments to identify all potential hazards associated with working at height, and taking into account the nature of work and the working environment;
- 2. Provide and maintain suitable and adequate safe means of access to and egress from every place of work;
- 3. Ensure that every working platform is properly planked; and every plank rests securely and evenly on its supports;
- 4. Ensure that all nearby dangerous edges, openings or void spaces are properly fenced off or covered and so constructed as to prevent fall of persons, materials
- 5. If these are not reasonably practicable, set up a fall arresting system and provide necessary equipment to every worker concerned; and
- 6. Ensure to provide workers with adequate information, instruction and training to ensure that they are familiar with the safe work procedures and safety measures.

Provide guard-rails, toe-boards and warning signs at the floor opening

As Frontline Supervisor / Worker:

- 1. Ensure the works are carried out in strict accordance with the method statement, safety procedures and safety measures;
- 2. Implement an effective monitoring and control system to ensure all safety measures are strictly followed by workers;
- 3. Worker should stop work and report to supervisor immediately when he /she encounter unsafe environment or there is inadequate personal protection equipment provided to him/her; and
- 4. Do not make unauthorized alteration to the protective measures.

As a Safety Practitioner:

1. Assist the employer to ensure that safety measures are strictly followed, and to report any non-compliances.

The above only listed out key points of safety, for more information please make reference to the 《Construction Site (Safety) Regulations》, the 《Guidance Notes on Classification and Use of Safety Belts and their Anchorage Systems》 issued by the Labour Department and (Work-at-Height Safety Handbook) issued by the CIC.
