<u>CIC Successfully Held CIC Conference 2012</u> <u>"Manpower Sustainability of Construction Industry cum</u> <u>Zero Carbon Building Development in Hong Kong"</u>

Hong Kong • 28 September 2012 – The Construction Industry Council (CIC) today announced the successful hosting of the CIC Conference 2012. The theme of the event this year is "Manpower Sustainability of Construction Industry cum Zero Carbon Building Development in Hong Kong".

Introduction

The one-day event was aimed at looking into the manpower trends and issues facing the local construction industry. Local and overseas professionals were invited to share their views in achieving manpower sustainability. Another major focus of the conference was the development of the CIC's ZCB, the first zero carbon building in Hong Kong. Experts from abroad also spoke about their experience in the construction and maintenance of their zero carbon projects. Mr. Paul CHAN, Secretary for Development, Mr. WONG Kam-sing, Secretary for the Environment, and Ir WAI Chi-sing, Permanent Secretary for Development (Works), meanwhile, were present to deliver insightful remarks.

"We also wish to draw the industry's attention to developing sustainable buildings in Hong Kong. We hope the CIC's development of the ZCB, the first zero carbon building in Hong Kong, can serve as a real-life example that this can indeed be achieved", Mr. LEE Shing-see, Chairman of the CIC, added.
