## 3.3 **Security of Payment**

## 3.3.1 Guidelines on Dispute Resolution

Members took note of the Paper CIC/SBC/P/014/09 and received a presentation from Ms. Teresa Cheng on the dispute resolution measures recommended for implementation by the industry.

Members agreed that disputes should be resolved speedily and cost effectively to minimise the impact on the cash flow which was critical to sustain normal operations of contractors. Members recommended that the dispute resolution measures as explained in the Paper, namely

#### **Action**

Mediation, Adjudication, Arbitration, Independent Expert Certifier and Expert Determination should be included in both public and private construction contracts to allow contracting parties to have more flexibility to deal with different types of disputes. Members also acknowledged the successful experience in adopting the Dispute Resolution Advisor (DRA) in government contracts to resolve disagreements before they were evolved into disputes. Hence, Members agreed that the DRA could be introduced to the private sector for consideration.

The Secretariat was directed to assist Ms. Teresa Cheng to update the Paper as per Members' comments before submitting to CIC Meeting for discussion.

As the information pack covered some issues that had been raised but not yet fully deliberated at the Committee, Members considered the Paper should be treated as an internal document for the CIC members' information instead of a guideline. Members took note of the Paper CIC/SBC/P/010/09. Task Force of the survey would continue to monitor the survey and report the progress to Members at the meeting. According to the planned schedule, the survey would be completed by end of September this year and HKU would present the findings at the Committee meeting and CIC meeting.

## 3.4 Protection of Workers' Entitlement to Wage Payment

3.4.1 Guidelines on Measures for Protection of Workers' Entitlement to Wage Payment

#### Action

Members took note of the Paper CIC/SBC/P/011/09 and agreed that private sector should be encouraged to implement those practices already implemented in public contracts. Some Members suggested amendments to some of the measures recommended in the guidelines. It was agreed that the recommended measures in the guidelines were provided for reference only and the users should make proper adjustments to suit their projects. Hence, there was no need to include everything at this stage for the purpose of issuing the guidelines. Members endorsed the guidelines for submission to the CIC.

Some Members remarked that while there was obvious improvement in protecting the workers' wage payment in public contracts, there were still late wage payment incidents happened for interior decoration and maintenance works. Therefore, the protection measures should be kept reviewing for better protecting the workers.
