Meeting No.001/18 of the Construction Industry Training Board was held on 30 January 2018 at 9:30am at Board Room, 38/F, COS Centre, 56 Tsun Yip Street, Kwun Tong, Kowloon.

1.6	CIC/CTB/P/004/18 (for endorsement)	Progression Pathway for Graduates of Construction Diploma Programme of Year 2017-2018  Members took note of the paper CIC/CTB/P/004/18 and endorsed the proposed progression pathway for gradates of Construction Diploma Programme of Year 2017-2018. If graduates wish to have further study, they may consider joining Apprenticeship Scheme and continue to study the Diploma of Foundation Studies (Engineering) offered by Vocational Training Council ("VTC") or even Higher Diploma. CIC will provide subsidies to employers who join the apprenticeship programme and the total estimated additional budget for two years is \$9,785,000. Alternatively, they may join the Advanced Construction Manpower Training Scheme - Pilot Scheme ("ACMTS-Pilot Scheme"). Participants of either one of the schemes may become a skilled worker and specified trade supervisor / site supervisor. To provide progression pathway for the graduates, Members also agreed to add "joiner" to ACMTS-Pilot Scheme under category 2 with a training period of two years and the stipulated wages and proposed subsidies from CIC will be same as those for the metal worker, painter and decorator. (Remark: A paper on "Progression Pathway for Graduates of Construction Diploma Programme of Year 2017-2018" was submitted to the CIC Council and approved by the Council Members at Meeting No.001/18 on 9 February 2018.)

1.3	CIC/CTB/P/001/18 (for approval)	Organisation Structure and Membership of CITB in 2018  Members accepted the proposed organisation structure (Annex A) and membership of CITB in 2018. There would be HKICMB, three task forces, two task groups and 18 course advisory panels (CAP) under CITB. As conservation of built heritages might not be the focus for CITB for the time being, Members agreed to dissolve the Task Group on Heritage Maintenance. CITB member Ir YU Sai-yen was appointed as the Chairperson of Task Group on Construction Safety Courses. The terms of office for all task forces and task groups would be from 1 January to 31 December 2018 while for CAP would remain unchanged as 2 years, i.e. from 1 January 2018 to 31 December 2019.
1.4	CIC/CTB/P/002/18 (for information)	List of Machinery Equipment to be replaced in 2018  Members took note of paper CIC/CTB/P/002/18. It was noted that a total of 4 machineries needed to be replaced in 2018. These include a crawler type telescopic mobile crane, a wheeled telescopic mobile crane and two excavators. It was agreed that there was no need to submit paper to CITB if related budget had already been approved by CITB before.
