A hearing of appeal by the Appeal Panel of the SRS was conducted on 24 July 2013. b. A hearing of regulatory actions by the Management Committee was conducted on 24 September 2013 involving four Registered Subcontractors all related to fatal accidents. c. The West Kowloon Cultural District Authority was approached on 21 August 2013 to solicit their support for using SRS in their project(s) and positive feedback had been received.
