3.4	CIC/CPT/P/008/18 (for information)	Subcontractor Registration Scheme (SRS) Operations  Members took note of the report on SRS Operations. There were 5,973 companies registered under the SRS with an increase of around 42 Registered Subcontractors compared to that of the last report in June 2018. A total of 132 regulatory actions had been taken against subcontractors mainly for late payments of workers' wages, MPF contributions and contraventions of safety regulations involved fatality.  CITAC guided tours were held on 21 July and 25 August 2018 for introducing the newly established CITAC Centre. Furthermore, "Subcontractor Technovation Series: BIM Practical Application Seminar is scheduled on 20 September 2018 with 133 participants enrolled.
3.5	-	Views on the proposed Security of Payment Legislation for the Construction Industry Members took note on the proposed Security of Payment Legislation for the Construction Industry and invited to deliberate on the upcoming initiatives by the Committee.  Mr. Albert Cheng briefed Members the different views from stakeholders and the current status of the consultation.
3.6	-	Task Force on Selection of Contractors  Members noted that the Reference Material on Selection of Contractors was being finalised taking in account the comments received from the Peer Review Group and HKCA. Upon the final endorsement by the Task Force Members, the Reference Materials would be presented to the Com-CPT accordingly.
3.7	-	Task Force on RMAA Procurement Members noted that the return for the Expression of Interest for the research study on Factors Affecting Consultants and Contractors in Hong Kong in Participating in the Repair, Maintenance, Alteration and Addition (RMAA) Sector. Selection of appropriate tenderers was in progress and the stage 2 Tender Invitation would be carried out in October 2018.
