2.5	CIC/CTB/P/014/20 (for approval)	Proposed Adjustment to Training Allowances for Full-time Course Members took note of paper CIC/CTB/P/014/20, and approved the proposal that the training subsidies of full-time courses for the year 2019/20 would remain unchanged. Members also noted that the government had suggested in 2019 that there would be an allocation of HK\$ 50 million to increase the training subsidies of the Certificates in Construction and Diploma in Construction. The submission was unanimously supported by the Panel on Development of the Legislative Council on 28 May 2019 while had not been presented to the Finance Committee of the Legislative Council for discussion and approval. The government had suggested reserving the funding in the estimated expenditure of financial year of 2020-21. The increased subsidies would be calculated from the approval date of the "Appropriation Bill 2020"(Bill). In order to attract more young people to enrol in the one-year full-time courses, the HKIC has raised the training allowance from HK\$3,600 to HK\$4,800 since September 2019. Thus, CIC would be responsible for the payment of extra training allowance during the period between 1 September 2019 and the day before the commencement of the Bill.
