<u>Subsidy for Employers of Long-term Casual Employees in the Construction</u> <u>Sector under the "Anti-Epidemic Fund" - Now Open for Application</u>

Hong Kong • 6 July 2020 – The Construction Industry Council (CIC) announces that the Employment Support Scheme for the Construction Sector (ESSC) supporting employers who have employed casual employees on a long-term basis is now open for application.

This new measure for the construction sector under the "Anti-epidemic Fund" (the Fund) aims to supplement the scope not covered by the Employment Support Scheme (ESS) and provide further support to the industry.

If an employer in the construction sector has made contributions for a "casual employee" under Mandatory Provident Fund (MPF) Industry Schemes for at least 15 days in March 2020, the employee will be regarded as a "qualified employee". An employer may apply for a subsidy of \$36,000 per "qualified employee", but must undertake not to make their employees redundant between August 2020 and January 2021, and to spend the full amount of the subsidy on paying wages to their "qualified employees".

Applicants have to authorise the MPF trustees to provide their MPF contribution data in March 2020 and from August 2020 to January 2021 to both the HKSAR government and the CIC. The contribution data will be used to determine the number of "qualified employee" and the amount of subsidy, and will also be used in the future to monitor the applicant's compliance with their undertakings.

Applicants have to download the application forms and relevant documents from the CIC's website (www.cic.hk/eng/main/anti_epidemic_fund_2nd/), and submit their applications by email (essc_application@devb.gov.hk) to the Development Bureau between 6 July 2020 and 31 July 2020. Late submissions will not be accepted. It is expected that the subsidy will be disbursed to successful applicants via auto-payment within six to eight weeks after receipt of valid applications.
