## **Statement by the Construction Industry Council in Response to the Incident at the CIC-Zero Carbon Park**

**Hong Kong • 30 November 2023** – The Construction Industry Council (CIC) confirms an incident happened at the CIC-Zero Carbon Park this afternoon, involving a male demolition worker of an event contractor during demolition of an event stage. The graduation ceremony of the Hong Kong Institute of Construction was held in the morning. Worker was conscious with limb injury and was rushed to hospital. The CIC has sent staff to accompany the worker and provides necessary assistance.

The CIC has immediately contacted the relevant contractor to look into the matter and to understand if the safety guidelines were complied.
