5.7	CIC/RSC/P/050/19 - CIC/RSC/P/058/19 (for information)	 Regulatory Hearing (a) As of the end of October 2019, a cumulative total of 171 registered companies were sanctioned under the Scheme and in which 32 of them were conducted in 2019; (b) The fifth regulatory hearing of 2019 was conducted. A total of nine cases arising from fatal accidents, late payment of MPF contributions and wage arrears were handled. Written warning or suspension of registration were imposed on the companies concerned.
