1.20 Confirmation of Minutes of the Previous Meeting (Open-door Session)

Members referred to Paper CIC/CMT/M/006/24 and confirmed the minutes of the open-door session of the 6th meeting of 2024 held on Friday, 13 December 2024 at the Board Room, 29/F, Tower 2, Enterprise Square Five (MegaBox), 38 Wang Chiu Road, Kowloon Bay, Kowloon, Hong Kong.

1.21 Matters Arising from the Previous Meeting (Open-door Session)

Item 6.25 An update on the progress of the preparatory work prior to the implementation of the Construction Industry Security of Payment Ordinance in August 2026 had been reported by CTN under Item 1.10 above. PSW also proposed that the Development Bureau brief Members on major items of the Security of Payment Legislation at the next Council meeting.

Item 6.29 On the request of the Chairman, the R&D Team confirmed with Prof. Louis WONG from the University of Hong Kong, Principal Investigator of the "PreLogging" project, that the "PreLogging" was the first research project of its kind. He also stated that the CEDD/GEO (Geotechnical Engineering Office of the Civil Engineering and Development Department) had a strong interest in applying this product in their projects.

The R&D Team was assisting with the implementation and promotion of "PreLogging". On the promotion side, the R&D Conference for the online promotion of "PreLogging" was held on 19

December 2024. In addition, a webinar coorganised by the CIC, HKIE GEO Division and the IOM3 (The Institute of Materials, Minerals & Mining) HK Branch was scheduled for Q2 2025 to further promote the product to end users. Prof. WONG would be encouraged to publish his work, if possible. The R&D Team would also explore suitable CIC occasions and industry events for Prof. WONG to participate in and promote "PreLogging".

The Chairman suggested that the promotion work for this R&D project could be conducted collaboratively with the Building Technology Research Institute.

In response to PSW's enquiry about the intellectual property ownership of "PreLogging", which determines whether the CIC, as the R&D project funder, would need to pay to use it, AHKK would confirm later.

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1.22 Summary Notes of 4th Meeting of Committee on Building Information Modelling and Construction Digitalisation for 2024

JCCp highlighted that a BIM and Construction Digitalisation Adoption Survey would be conducted in 2025 with the aim of carrying out a holistic review of the demand and supply of BIM personnel. He appealed for Members' support in participating in the survey.

In response to the Chairman's query on the industry's readiness for the full adoption of digitalisation for projects over HK\$300 million starting in 2026, JCCp confirmed that this would be covered in the Survey and a roadmap would be formulated accordingly. The Chairman also suggested developing a roadmap to equip SMEs in becoming fully digitalised at its next meeting.

CLWK highlighted the progress of the CIC Green Product Certification Enhancement Study for Members' information. The total number of product categories had increased from 28 to 32. The launching ceremony was scheduled for April 2025. The next step would be to conduct a supplemental study on how to effectively implement this in the industry.

The Chairman stated that there were discussions on exploring potential ways for encouraging more suppliers to supply green products, particularly reinforcing bars and concrete, at the last Com-EXE meeting on 17 January 2025. CLWK replied that a budget had been set aside to include this in Stage 2 of the study on "the Development of CIC Green Product Certification Accreditation and Standards for Low Carbon Materials / Products Categories".

At the Chairman's request, new technologies from the Mainland, such as DeepSeek and robot dance performances showcased in the Spring Festival Gala, would be explored and leveraged for practical applications in Hong Kong.
