Site visit had been done in March on setting up the system in dump truck for a MTRC construction site. EPD had no objection on the RFID monitoring proposal. 2.4	CIC/EIT/P/009/15 (for endorsement)	<p>Research and Survey on the C&D Waste in Hong Kong</p> <p>A task group was proposed to form with the Chairmanship of Mr. Ringo YU. Key objective of the proposed Task Group were to study the composition of C&D waste and the strategies for management and reduction of construction waste. Chairman recommended the task group to further discuss on the proposed terms of reference.</p>
2.5	CIC/EIT/P/010/15 (for endorsement)	<p>Task Group on Establishment of Industry Standard for BIM Implementation</p> <p>A consultant was commissioned to prepare a set of BIM Standards (Phase One) that was suitable to Hong Kong's local practices in March 2014. A final draft had been endorsed by the task group after deliberation and consultation through a series of stakeholders' forum. The members endorsed the Standards as Reference Materials to be published on the CIC website.</p>
2.6	CIC/EIT/P/011/15 (for endorsement)	<p>Assignment Brief for BIM Standards to Facilitate the Submission of GBP for Statutory Authorities (Phase One)</p> <p>Members' comment had been incorporated into the assignment brief from last meeting.
