6.11 4th Meeting of Committee on Procurement for 2013

Members received a brief report by CT on Paper CIC/CMT/P/064/13.

The following issues were highlighted:

- Item 4.3 A Special Group on On-Demand Bonds was formed and the first meeting of the Special Group would be arranged shortly.
- Item 4.4 A research entitled "Assessing the Time Performance of Building Construction Projects in Hong Kong" would be conducted.
- Item 4.6 A roadmap and the related deliverables would be ready for discussion at the next Task Force meeting on Competition Law.
- Item 4.7 Upon receiving the comments from HKIS, the report of the Task Force on NEC3 Collaborative Contracts would be circulated to members of the Task Force again before issuance.
- Item 4.8 The draft Reference Materials on the Selection of Consultants would be ready subject to the clarification from the Chairman of the Task Force.
- Item 4.9 A fact sheet would be published, giving general information on the application of Owner-Controlled Insurance Programme in construction contracts.

Members had no comments on other items in Paper

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4th Meeting of Committee on Subcontracting for 2013 6.12

Members received brief a report by MW on Paper CIC/CMT/P/065/13.

The following issues were highlighted:

- Item 4.3 A new task force for the enhancement to the SRS would be set up in relation to the provision of positive incentives to registered subcontractors to enhance their qualities.
- Item 4.5 Adjudication could be taken as the default option for dispute resolution method and HKIAC could be the default appointing body for adjudicators. For the Independent Expert Certifier and Expert Determination, comments and suggestion on the default appointing body were still being deliberated.

CIC The Chairman concluded that although the application of guidelines by the industry was not discussed during the retreat, nevertheless it Secretariat should be added to the list of our follow up actions.

Members had other items no comments on in Paper CIC/CMT/P/065/13.

5th Meeting of Construction Industry Training Board for 2013 6.13

Members received brief report by CWG on Paper а CIC/CMT/P/066/13.

- Item 5.6 8 trades in tunnel works would be put under • Contractor Cooperative Training Scheme (CCTS). The number of related training places would be 250 with an estimated expenditure of over \$5 million.
- Item 5.11 The roadmap for CIC training development with • training pattern of 16 overseas countries was prepared. Α Retreat was organised setting out 3 strategic directions and 18 goals on CIC training for implementation by CITB.
- Item 5.12 to 5.18 An independent review working group would be established to review training courses and trade tests of CIC. The review timeframe would be 6 months. The productivity of graduates would be compared with the workers

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with four and seven years of experience respectively. The report on the comparison of productivity would be ready in two months' time. CITB would also explore co-operation opportunities in organising E&M construction training courses with VTC.

• Item 5.19 to 20 – A review was conducted regarding the retention rate of the graduates. The retention rate of the graduates for 2012 was 80% for 3 months and 60% for 6 months. The rate for 2013 was 80% for 6 months.

On items 5.12 to 5.18, it was suggested that care should be taken when reviewing the courses made by the Course Advisory Panel.
