(a) Construction Industry Lo Pan Rice Campaign: Distributes free meal boxes to the communities in need every Friday evening, beneficiaries include low-income families, the unemployed, singleton elderlies, people with limited mobility, ethnic minorities, subdivided households, homeless people, etc. (b) Construction Industry Blood Donation Day: Collaborating with Hong Kong Red Cross, the blood donation stations have been set up at HKIC, CIC-ZCP as well as the offices / sites of participating companies in the industry.
