1.24 Confirmation of Minutes of the Previous Meeting (Open-door Session)

Members referred to Paper CIC/CMT/M/006/22 and confirmed the minutes of the open-door session of the 6th meeting of 2022 held on Friday, 9 December 2022 at the Board Room, 29/F, Tower 2, Enterprise Square Five (MegaBox), 38 Wang Chiu Road, Kowloon Bay, Kowloon, Hong Kong.

Members received Paper CIC/CMT/P/020/23 without comments.

1.27 Summary Notes of 4th Meeting of Committee on Construction Business Development for 2022

Members took note of Paper CIC/CMT/P/021/23.

LKP, Chairperson of the Committee on Construction Business Development, highlighted that the establishment of the Task Force on Review and Enhancement of Construction Contract Terms had been approved. Topics related to cash flow, variation orders, etc. would be covered.

Members received Paper CIC/CMT/P/021/23 without comments.

1.28 Summary Notes of 4th Meeting of Committee on Construction Safety (Com-CSY) for 2022

[Mr. Tony LAM, Head of Construction Safety (Acting) joined the meeting at this juncture.]

Action

Members took note of Paper CIC/CMT/P/022/23.

Mr. Tony LAM highlighted the following items:

- (a) there were 17 fatalities (14 industrial incidents) in the construction industry in 2022 and as at mid-February 2023, there were already two fatalities;
- (b) the scopes of the Action Plan concluded in the Construction Safety Summit 2022 were
 - (i) rethink site safety culture;
 - (ii) Design for Safety;
 - (iii) Smart Site for Safety; and
 - (iv) improve Site Safety Management System;
- (c) the monthly "Life First Walk the Talk" webinar had commenced and safety videos had been uploaded on the CIC website;
- (d) the Labour Department had confirmed that the 2-day Foundation Certificate in Construction Safety Course could be open to the public for registration;
- (e) the CIC Master Class on Design for Safety (Project Managers) and CIC Master Class on Temporary Works (Engineers and Supervisors) had commenced;
- (f) nine reference guidelines and materials, including "Fatal Zone Management" and "Hole Management", had been issued in these few months; and
- (g) the Com-CSY would explore the opportunity to engage private developers and public works contracts to conduct trials on the Design for Safety Management System.

The Chairman added that the Guidelines on Safety of Tower Cranes, in particular in areas related to inspection of critical parts, would be updated. He urged the industry to follow them strictly to increase the awareness on tower crane safety.

1.30 Summary Notes of 1st Meeting of Committee on Registered Specialist Trade Contractors Scheme for 2023

Members took note of Paper CIC/CMT/P/024/23.

OYL highlighted the following items:

- (a) the Committee on Registered Specialist Trade Contractors Scheme (Com-RSC) would continue to review cases referred by the Independent Commission Against Corruption (ICAC) and would cooperate with the ICAC to promote corruption prevention to registered companies;
- (b) appropriate regulatory actions would continue to be taken against registered companies involved in serious safety incidents;
- (c) as of end December 2022, the total number of registered companies was 7,685; and
- (d) levelling and setting out trade would be added as the 12th designated trade under the Registered Specialist Trade Contractors Scheme from 1 March 2023.

In response to the Chairman's concern, OYL reported that the ICAC, the DEVB and the CIC had jointly launched an Integrity Charter campaign in 2021. Noting that there were quite a number of corruption cases in the past few months, the Chairman requested CTN to revisit the matter and liaise with ICAC to launch

a campaign, such as signing another charter, to increase the awareness on corruption prevention of the entire industry. OYL informed Members that a seminar on corruption prevention and integrity management for the construction industry (建造業防貪及誠信管理研討會) would be organised with ICAC and DEVB in May 2023. A corruption prevention talk/speech was being planned with the ICAC for the RMAA (Repair, Maintenance, Alteration and Addition) promotional event to be held in late March 2023. ELM added that he would liaise with ICAC to further enhance the awareness of corruption prevention among RMAA practitioners.

Members received Paper CIC/CMT/P/024/23 without further comments.

1.31 Summary Notes of 1st Meeting of Construction Industry Training Board for 2023

Members took note of Paper CIC/CMT/P/025/23.

ELM, Chairperson of the Construction Industry Training Board, expressed his appreciation for the high training output (over 7,000 graduates) by the Hong Kong Institute of Construction (HKIC) and collaborative training in 2022. The CITB would continue to boost the training output through the HKIC and the collaborative training schemes.
