* The application fee is refundable for the applicant who successfully applied for either Truss-out Scaffolder Safety Training before 31 December 2023, upon the completion of the safety training and achievement of an overall pass result by 30 September 2024.

Candidate who fails the practical test and the test result is far below the passing requirement and applies for a re-sit within 6 months (for IOS) / 1 year (for TOS) have to pay a surcharge of HK\$400 (for IOS) / HK\$800 (for TOS). Surcharge incurred in the re-submission is refundable upon achievement of an overall pass result in the related test.

Absentee applying for a re-sit within 6 months (for IOS) / 1 year (for TOS) have to pay a surcharge of HK\$400 (for IOS) / HK\$800 (for TOS). The test date will be scheduled to a later date.

Guides to Applicants

- The test fees listed may be reviewed and adjusted by the CIC if necessary without prior notice.
- Applicants who have completed the safety training and passed the written test and practical assessment will be issued a "Advanced Level Truss-out Scaffolder Safety Training Certificate"/ "Intermediate Level Truss-out Scaffolder Safety Training Certificate".
- Applicants who are not Hong Kong Permanent Residents, please attach the copy of valid working permit issued by the Hong Kong Immigration Department.
- Applicants who reach the age of 65, please call Hong Kong Construction Industry Trade Testing Centre 2100 9000 for checking the trades that may be required to submit medical examination reports issued by Registered Medical Practitioners and acquiring the standard forms of reports.
- Applicants may request for postponement of safety training by submitting his/her reasons in writing. Such letter must reach CIC **at least 3 working days** before the scheduled training day. If the reason is accepted by the HKCITTC, the applicant can reschedule 1 time for free.
- CIC reserves all rights to amend safety training arrangement, including but not limited to accept any safety training/ test/ course application and/ or change the relevant clauses in a timely manner without giving any reasons or explanations, and CIC will not accept any liability in respect of claims for expenses or other damages.
- Notice for candidates:
 - (1) Candidates must show their **valid Construction Industry Safety Training Certificate (Green Card)** and wear suitable work wear including safety shoes; otherwise, you will not be able to attend the practical test and be treated as an absence.
 - (2) Candidates who arrive late are not allowed to enter the workshop will be treated as an absence.
- Application
 - (1) Complete the application form together with a cheque or bank draft for the test fee payable to "Construction Industry Council".
 - (2) A **photocopy** of the applicant's **Hong Kong ID Card and "Construction Industry Safety Training Course Certificate" (Green Card)** must be affixed on the application form. The copy will be destroyed once the information of the applicant has been verified
 - (3) Send the completed application form, supporting document (Point 4 of above) and together with a cheque or bank draft to the Hong Kong Construction Industry Trade Testing Centre, 38/F, COS Centre, 56 Tsun Yip Street Kwun Tong, Kowloon
 - (4) All trade test fees are non-refundable and non-transferrable. Candidates who want to withdraw from the tests have to submit their reasons in writing to the CIC at least 3 working days before the schedule test date. An administration fee amounting to 20% of the paid test fee will be charged. Special consideration will be given to candidates who request to withdraw because of prolonged injury.

Whether or not you provide your personal data to the CIC is voluntary. However, where you are providing information for the purpose of an application, it is necessary that you supply the CIC with complete information as specified on the application form. Otherwise, the CIC may be unable to process or consider your application. If you are under the age of 18, you should consult your parent or guardian before providing any personal data to us.</p> <p>1.3. You are entitled to request access to and correction of any errors in your personal data.
