- Note:** (1) To apply for the "Advanced Level Truss-out Scaffolder Safety Training", applicants must hold the "Bamboo Scaffolder Trade Test Certificate". To apply for the "Intermediate Level Truss-out Scaffolder Safety Training", applicants must hold the "Bamboo Scaffolder Intermediate Trade Test Certificate" qualification.
- (2) Candidates who fail the practical test and whose test results are far below the passing requirement and who apply for a re-sit within 6 months (for IOS) / 1 year (for TOS) have to pay a surcharge of HK\$500 (for IOS) / HK\$1,000 (for TOS). The surcharge incurred in the re-submission is refundable upon achieving an overall pass result in the related test.
- (3) Absentees applying for a re-sit within 6 months (for IOS) / 1 year (for TOS) have to pay a surcharge of HK\$500 (for IOS) / HK\$1,000 (for TOS). The test date will be scheduled for a later date. The related surcharge is not refundable.
- (4) *The application fee is refundable for applicants who successfully applied for either Truss-out Scaffolder Safety Training before 31 December 2024, upon the completion of the safety training and achievement of an overall pass result by 31 December 2025.

- The test fees listed may be reviewed and adjusted by the CIC if necessary without prior notice.
- Applicants who have completed the safety training and passed the written test and practical assessment will be issued an “Advanced Level Truss-out Scaffolder Safety Training Certificate” or an “Intermediate Level Truss-out Scaffolder Safety Training Certificate”.
- Applicants who are not Hong Kong Permanent Residents, please attach the copy of valid working permit issued by the Hong Kong Immigration Department.
- Applicants who have reached the age of 65, please call Hong Kong Construction Industry Trade Testing Centre at 2100 9000 to check which trades may require the submission of medical examination reports issued by Registered Medical Practitioners and to acquire the standard form of reports (BC form).
- Applicants may request a postponement of training/test/course by submitting their reasons in writing. Such a letter must reach the CIC **at least 3 working days** before the scheduled test/course day. If the reason is accepted by the CIC, the applicant can reschedule once for free.
- The CIC reserves all rights to amend training/test/course arrangement, including but not limited to accepting any training/test/course application and/or changing the relevant clauses in a timely manner without giving any reasons. The CIC will not accept any liability in respect of claims for expenses or other damages.
- Notice for candidates:
 - (1) Candidates must show their **valid Construction Industry Safety Training Certificate (Green Card)** and **wear suitable work wear including safety shoes**; otherwise, you will not be able to attend the practical test and be treated as absent.
 - (2) Candidates who arrive late are not allowed to enter the workshop and will be treated as absent.
- Application:
 - (1) Complete the application form together with a cheque or bank draft for the test fee payable to “Construction Industry Council”.
 - (2) A **photocopy** of the applicant’s **HKID Card***, **“Construction Industry Safety Training Course Certificate” (Green Card)** and **“Bamboo Scaffolder Trade Test Certificate/ Intermediate Trade Test Certificate”** must be affixed on the application form.
**If the applicant does not wish to submit a copy of the HKID card, the applicant can present the original of HKID for verification in person at the Kowloon Bay Workers Registration Service Center(KBCWR), Nan Cheong Workers Registration Service Centre(NCWR) or the Hong Kong Construction Industry Trade Testing Centre (HKCITTTC), Aberdeen within 30 calendar days of application submitted.*
 - (3) Send the completed application form, a copy of supporting documents (Pt. 2 of above) and a cheque or bank draft to the Hong Kong Construction Industry Trade Testing Centre, 38/F, COS Centre, 56 Tsun Yip Street Kwun Tong, Kowloon.
 - (4) All fees are non-refundable and non-transferrable. Applicants who want to withdraw from the training/test/course have to submit their reasons in writing to the CIC at least 3 working days before the schedule test/training/course date. An administration fee amounting to 20% of the paid fee will be charged. Special consideration will be given to candidates who request to withdraw because of prolonged injury.

**[Personal Information Collection Statement]****1. Collection of Personal Data**

1.1. The information you provide to the Construction Industry Council, its affiliates, and / or its subsidiaries, including, but not limited to, the Hong Kong Institute of Construction and Zero Carbon Building, Construction Sector Imported Labour Quarters Limited (collectively, the "CIC"), including any personal data as defined in the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance (Cap.486), will be used solely for purposes related to the activities of the CIC. The activity and the required personal data are detailed in the application form [This Personal Information Collection Statement should be attached or printed on the application form].

1.2. Whether or not you provide your personal data to the CIC is voluntary. However, where you are providing information for the purpose of an application, it is necessary that you supply the CIC with complete information as specified on the application form. Otherwise, the CIC may be unable to process or consider your application. If you are under the age of 18, you should consult your parent or guardian before providing any personal data to us.

1.3. You are entitled to request access to and correction of any errors in your personal data. 2. Purposes of Collection

Your personal data will be kept confidential and may be used by the CIC for the following purposes:

- Performing and exercising functions and powers of the CIC under relevant legislation, rules and sub-legislation, including but not limited to the Construction Industry Council Ordinance (Cap. 587) and Construction Workers Registration Ordinance (Cap. 583);
- Registering for the trade test/course/safety training/skill assessment or any other services which you apply for on the application form and assessing your eligibility thereto related;
- Supporting all logistics and operational measures (including but not limited to administration, security, health and safety related etc.) in place in the HKCITTC, implemented at discretion of the HKCITTC for the best interest of the public and stakeholders;
- Responding to situations involving risk of health and safety, including an emergency, possibly incurred during the course of the trade test/course/safety training/skill assessment or any other services;
- Keeping and maintaining qualification records;
- Conducting trade test/course/safety training/skill assessment inspections, invigilation, review and assessment;
- Facilitating communication with you, for example by means of SMS, WhatsApp, WeChat and/or other communication platforms/channels;
- Establishing, exercising and defending the CIC's legal rights, and complying with the CIC's legal and regulatory obligations (including anti-money laundering obligations, complying with orders by courts or regulators, etc.);

I consent to the CIC will not be accountable for any injuries and deaths incurred due to my negligence.

3. I understand and agree that the HKCITTC reserves all rights to reject my second test application (i.e. re-sit) where I fail to comply with the HKCITTC regulations and/or to present myself to the tests/courses without a valid justification.

4. I understand and agree that the HKCITTC reserves all rights to reject my test/course applications; and to deny my test eligibility at its sole discretion without any refund/compensation liability. The HKCITTC also reserves all rights of final decision and interpretation in relation to any such decisions under no obligation to provide any further notice nor explanation.

5. I authorise the HKCITTC to verify my qualifications and/or obtain information in relation to the qualifications direct from the issuing authorities and consent to the direct transfer of such information between the issuing authorities and the HKCITTC.
