To apply for the "Advanced Level Truss-out Scaffolder Safety Training", applicant must hold the "Bamboo Scaffolder Trade Test Certificate". To apply for the "Intermediate Level Truss-out Scaffolder Safety Training", applicant must hold the "Bamboo Scaffolder Intermediate Trade Test Certificate" qualification.

* The application fee is refundable for the applicant who successfully applied for either Truss-out Scaffolder Safety Training before 31 December 2023, upon the completion of the safety training and achievement of an overall pass result by 30 September 2024.

Candidate who fails the practical test and the test result is far below the passing requirement and applies for a re-sit within 6 months (for IOS) / 1 year (for TOS) have to pay a surcharge of HK\$400 (for IOS) / HK\$800 (for TOS). Surcharge incurred in the re-submission is refundable upon achievement of an overall pass result in the related test.

Absentee applying for a re-sit within 6 months (for IOS) / 1 year (for TOS) have to pay a surcharge of HK\$400 (for IOS) / HK\$800 (for TOS). The test date will be scheduled to a later date.

- Applicants who have completed the safety training and passed the written test and practical assessment will be issued a "Advanced Level Truss-out Scaffolder Safety Training Certificate".
- If applicant is not a permanent resident in Hong Kong, please attach a copy of valid work permit issued by the Hong Kong Immigration Department.
- If the applicant is 65 years of age or above, he/she is required to produce a medical certificate issued by a registered medical practitioner to certify
 that he/she is fit to undertake the safety training. Please contact Hong Kong Construction Industry Trade Testing Centre at 2100 9000 for more
 details.
- Applicant may request for postponement of safety training by submitting his/her reasons in writing. Such letter must reach CIC at least 3 working days before the scheduled training day. If the reason is accepted by the HKCITTC, the applicant can reschedule 1 time for free.
- CIC reserves all rights to amend safety training arrangement, including but not limited to accept any safety training/ test/ course application and/ or change the relevant clauses in a timely manner without giving any reasons or explanations, and CIC will not accept any liability in respect of claims for expenses or other damages.
- During the training day(s):
 - (1) Applicants must show their valid Construction Industry Safety Training Certificate (Green Card) and wear suitable work wear including safety shoes; otherwise, you will not be able to attend the safety training and be treated as an absence.
 - (2) Applicants who arrive late are not allowed to enter the workshop will be treated as an absence.

- (1) Complete the application form together with a cheque or bank draft for the fee payable to "Construction Industry Council",
- (2) A photocopy of the applicant's Hong Kong ID Card, "Construction Industry Safety Training Course Certificate" (Green Card) and "Bamboo Scaffolder Trade Test Certificate" must be affixed on the application form,
- (3) Send the completed application form, supporting document (Point 2 of above) and together with a cheque or bank draft to the Hong Kong Construction Industry Trade Testing Centre, 38/F, COS Centre, 56 Tsun Yip Street Kwun Tong, Kowloon, and
- (4) All fees are non-refundable and non-transferrable. Applicants who want to withdraw from the safety training have to submit their reasons in writing to the CIC at least 3 working days before the schedule training date. An administration fee amounting to 20% of the paid test fee will be charged. Special consideration will be given to candidates who request to withdraw because of prolonged injury.

- 1. I hereby declare that all information provided by me on this application form and all documents submitted with this application are true and correct, to the best of my knowledge. I understand that giving false or misleading statement or information in the safety training/test/course application and/or for worker registration may constitute criminal offense and the application and/or registration may be deemed invalid.

I shall, if my application is accepted, conform to the Code of Practice for Trade Test of the Hong Kong Construction Industry Trade Test Centre ("HKCITTC"), which covers safety guidelines, disciplinary guidelines and guidance/instructions given from the invigilator during the safety training/test/course etc., with details available in the Construction Industry Council ("CIC") website. I will be responsible for the indemnification incurred in any damage of machines, tools and equipment resulted from my negligence or willful misconduct during the safety training/test/course. I consent to the CIC will not be accountable for any injuries and deaths incurred due to my negligence.
- 3. I understand and agree that the HKCITTC reserves all rights to reject my second application (i.e. re-sit) where I fail to comply with the HKCITTC regulations and/or to present myself to the safety training/tests/courses without a valid justification.

The HKCITTC also reserves all rights of final decision and interpretation in relation to any such decisions under no obligation to provide any further notice nor explanation.
