



EQUIP EXCAVATORS WITH ADDITIONAL SAFETY DEVICES

Limit the highest reach of the excavator







A dynamic risk assessment should also be carried out before operating an excavator, including:

- **▼** Properly fence off the operating area of the excavator and display appropriate warning signs.
- The lookout man should be outside the operating area to check and ensure that no pedestrians are entering or staying in the operating area at any time.
- Check safety equipment such as rearview mirrors, CCTVs, sensors and alert systems on excavators to ensure that they are in good operating condition.
- Conduct field control briefing to ensure that the relevant workers are aware of the risks of the site environment and the associated safety measures.
