## **Recruitment Day for Ethnic Minorities**

Hong Kong • 22 August 2012 – To cope with the booming growth of the infrastructure projects, railway development and various construction works, the construction industry predicts that there will be a strong demand for new entrants for the workforce in the next few years. Besides local professionals, there are also a number of construction workers with different ethnic backgrounds participating in the industry. To attract more ethnic minorities to join the industry, the Construction Industry Council Training Academy, with the support from the Hong Kong Construction Industry Employees General Union will organize "**Recruitment Day for Ethnic Minorities**" on coming Sunday (26/8).
