Outstanding Students Awarded Scholarship for Family Members of Registered Construction Workers

Hong Kong • **9 November 2019** – The Construction Industry Council (CIC) today presented the scholarship for family members of registered construction workers (Scholarship) and congratulated 26 scholarship award winners on their academic excellence and achievement in the 2019 Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination.

The Construction Industry Council established the "Scholarship for Family Members of Registered Construction Workers" (Scholarship) in 2011 to commend the immediate family members of the registered construction workers for their outstanding academic performance, and to recognize construction workers who have contributed to the development of a sustainable society while nurturing the next generation of talent. A total of 26 students participating in "Open Category" and "Construction Related Curricula Category" of the scholarship are awarded more than HK\$240,000.

Mr. CHAN Ka-kui, Chairman of the CIC, in the speech, was delighted to say that the world-class infrastructure in Hong Kong manifested the success and excellence of Hong Kong construction industry. Hong Kong construction practitioners, especially frontline workers, can justifiably be proud of themselves. Children of the workers should be proud of their parents too. Mr. Chan encouraged students to take a proverb in the construction industry- "one cannot draw squares or circles without the aid of compass or square"- as a motto. Rules and order should always be respected.

Ir Alfred LEUNG, Chairperson of the Workers Development and Welfare Sub-committee, made a remarks on behalf of Construction Workers Registration Board. In addition to congratulating the winning students, he encouraged construction workers to upgrade themselves and participate the upcoming "Continuing Professional Development Award Scheme" (Scheme). The Scheme aims to recognise and encourage workers for their continuous professional and multi-skills development.
