Outstanding Students Awarded Scholarship for Family Members of Registered Construction Workers

Hong Kong · 3 November 2020 - The Construction Industry Council (CIC) organised the 10th Award Ceremony for the Scholarship for Family Members of Registered Construction Workers (Scholarship) on 31 October. The number of applications reached a record high of more than 500 applications this year. A total of 30 awards with nearly HK\$280,000 scholarships were awarded to the families of construction workers who achieved outstanding results in the 2020 Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination.

The CIC established the Scholarship in 2011 to commend the immediate family members of registered construction workers for their outstanding academic performance and to recognise construction workers who have contributed to the development of a sustainable Hong Kong while nurturing the next generation of talents. The CIC has set up a category for "Construction Related Curricula Category" to encourage more students to join the construction industry after graduation and to build Hong Kong together.

Mr. CHAN Ka-kui, Chairman of the CIC, in his opening address said, "Hong Kong has the world-class infrastructure, which is attributed to the tirelss efforts of our outstanding talents. Hong Kong construction practitioners, especially frontline workers, can justifiably be proud of themselves, and children of workers should also be proud of their parents." Mr. CHAN cited a Mencius quote, "one cannot draw squares or circles without the aid of compass or square", encouraging students to respect rules and order.

Ir Kenneth MO, Chairperson of the Construction Workers Registration Board congratulated the student awardees in his speech. He also encouraged them to pursue and learn new knowledge while at the same time to grasp the opportunities brought by the development of the Greater Bay Area and to unleash their professional talents.
