The Construction Industry Council Fully Supports "Early Vaccination for All" Campaign

Hong Kong • 31 May 2021 –The Construction Industry Council (CIC) supports the HKSAR Government's "Early Vaccination for All" campaign. We believe a higher vaccination rate can help Hong Kong overcome the epidemic as soon as possible and let us resume our normal life. It can also better protect us even if the fifth wave of the epidemic attacks.

In order to encourage employees to get vaccinated, the CIC has granted "vaccination time off" and "vaccination day off" to staff since early April. Staff of the CIC can apply for time off if they arranged their vaccination on a working day, and apply for a day off to rest at home on the first working day after vaccination.
