Hong Kong • 6 May 2018 – The Construction Industry Council (CIC) today held the "Construction Industry Table Tennis Competition and Carnival 2018" (Event) at Pui Ching Primary School. Nearly 300 players from 40 organisations and their families and friends enjoyed a happy Sunday.

The other event highlights included game booths, craft workshop and photo-taking attractions. All the fun activities and games were well-received by the participants.

"Construction Industry Table Tennis Competition and Carnival" was organised by the Construction Industry Sports and Volunteering Programme (CISVP) launched by the CIC in 2016. CISVP aims to encourage a healthy lifestyle and instill a caring culture amongst industry practitioners.
