**The 12th Scholarship for Family Members of
Registered Construction Workers by the CIC
Awarded 41 Outstanding Students**

Hong Kong •10 November 2022 - The Construction Industry Council (CIC) organised an Award Ceremony of the 12th Scholarship for Family Members of Registered Construction Workers (Scholarship) on 5 November 2022. The Scholarship Programme received support from 13 Developers, Registered Specialist Trade Contractors, Construction Companies, and Public Organisations. A record high of total 41 awards with over HK\$340,000 scholarships were awarded to family members of construction workers who achieved outstanding results in the 2022 Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education Examination. In the award ceremony, the CIC also commended the awardees' family members who are registered skilled workers. It is hoped that other workers will be motivated to further their career through continuous studies and skill enhancement.

Ir Thomas HO, Chairman of the CIC, in his sharing with awarded students said that the construction industry is promulgating “digitalisation” and “new technologies” to enhance productivity and efficiency in their construction projects, as well as to create safe and smart sites for developing Hong Kong into a smart city. With the launch of various local projects and the strategic development planning for Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area, the construction industry will have ample opportunities in future. Ir HO encouraged the awarded students to seize the opportunities and contribute to our country and Hong Kong after graduation. He also welcomed new ideas from young generation for his continuous improvement.

Ir Simon LIU, Chairperson of the Construction Workers Registration Board congratulated the awarded students in his speech, as well as encouraged them to apply creative thinking in overcoming challenges in order to achieve results beyond expectation. He hoped that students would show care and be thankful to their parents.

The CIC established the Scholarship in 2011 to commend the immediate family members of registered construction workers for their outstanding academic performance and to recognise construction workers who have contributed to the development of a sustainable Hong Kong while nurturing the next generation of talent. The Scholarship consists of “Open Category” and “Construction Related Curricula Category”. The latter aims at encouraging more graduates to join the construction industry and work together to construct Hong Kong.
