Hong Kong • 13 December 2022 – The Construction Innovation Expo 2022 (CIExpo) that jointly organised by the Construction Industry Council, Centre of Science and Technology Industrial Development (CSTID), the Ministry of Housing and Urban-Rural Development of the People's Republic of China and Development Bureau (DevB) of the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region officially commenced today at the Hong Kong Convention and Exhibition Centre for consecutive 5 days. CIExpo strives to serve as a knowledge sharing platform with business opportunities for the industry, bringing the latest construction technologies from global to local and promoting the up-to-trend information on sustainability development to industry practitioners.

On the same day, Mr. Paul CHAN, Financial Secretary of HKSAR Government attended the Global Construction Summit to witness an insightful idea exchange session with participants from all over the world.

The CIC is committed to driving innovation and technology development for the industry. With the aim of recognising the contribution of key industry players, a total of 25 Innovation Awards and Merit Certificates were presented, covering the aspects of Construction Productivity, Construction Safety, Construction Sustainability and Young Innovators. Ir Thomas HO, Chairman of the CIC, congratulated to the awardees, "Our Construction Innovation Award has exactly put the spotlight on such spirit and passion in driving



innovation and new ideas, recognising those who have spearheaded the development, promotion and implementation of new construction materials, methods, and technologies that raise the competitiveness of the construction industry of Hong Kong."

The 5-day CIExpo, which showcases "Industralisation", "Digitalisation", "Automation" and "Modernisation" as 4 thematic zones, received overwhelming response that joined by over 150 exhibitors, expecting at least 10,000 visits in total. The CIC also signed Memorandum of Understanding with CSTID, Cyberport and Huawei, jointly upgrade the industry and uplift our professional quality. Government officials, renowned experts, academics and entrepreneurs with engineering and technology background are invited to be speakers of Global Construction Summit, Greater Bay Area Construction Summit, International Conference on MiC, Construction Digitalisation, Construction Safety & Health and Green Construction separately, to dive into this experiential and ceremonial occasion and to spark new ideas and innovations. In addition, to keep the industry abreast of market needs and changes, a business-matching zone is set up on-site as a one-stop shop to promote hybrid business networking, discover lucrative opportunities and offer practical solutions.

Besides, the CIC is pleased to arrange different technical tours to present successful projects, including The Tseung Kwan O Desalination Plant, Kai Tak Sports Park, Student Residence at Wong Chuk Hang Site for the University of Hong Kong, Organic Resources Recovery Centre Phase 2 (O · PARK2), The Quayside, Widening of Sai Sha Road, Site Formation Works at Kwu Tung North and Fanling North New Development Areas and Expansion of Sha Tau Kok Sewage Treatment Works, in which the industry experts and frontline workers could share their knowledge and experience to enhance our excellent quality.
