# 2023 Construction Industry Outstanding Young Person Award Presentation Ceremony and Hong Kong Young Construction Forum Bears Testimony to the Success of Young Industry Talents Leading the Way to a Golden Era

**Hong Kong • 16 December 2023** – The 2023 Construction Industry Outstanding Young Person Award (CIOYPA) Presentation Ceremony and Hong Kong Young Construction Forum (Forum) concluded on a high note today. Organised by the Construction Industry Council (CIC), Ms. Bernadette LINN, Secretary for Development, together with Ir Thomas HO, Chairman of the CIC, officiated the event.

Inaugurated in 2019, the CIOYPA is a biennial award which recognises young construction practitioners with remarkable achievements in their careers and outstanding contributions to the construction industry and society at large. This year, in its third edition, six young professionals in the industry were awarded (See Appendix) and engaged in an experience sharing session with Cr Michael WONG, the Awardee of the first CIOYPA. In addition, the biennial Hong Kong Young Construction Forum with the theme of "Youth Leads the Way: Igniting the Construction Golden Era" served as an exceptional platform for young industry professionals to share their vision for the future.

Speaking at the event, Ms. Bernadette LINN, Secretary for Development, said that the construction industry has developed into an inter-disciplinary and cross-sector profession, integrating the three key elements of innovation, project governance and management, and manpower development. Young people are an important manpower source for the construction industry. To lead the industry's development in the 21<sup>st</sup> century, they need to possess skills in the aforementioned areas.

She added that Hong Kong has always been the talent hub for the construction industry in the region, attracting different professionals for exchange and taking Hong Kong to a higher level in technology and project management. Leveraging the advantages of enjoying strong support of the motherland and being closely connected to the world, Hong Kong will collaborate with the other cities in the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macau Greater Bay Area (GBA) to develop GBA standards, and serve as a platform promoting the alignment of those standards with international standards. Hong Kong will also promote young professional exchange, with a view to developing Hong Kong into an international platform for training construction professionals.
