**“Truss-out Scaffolding” to be Included as a Designated Trade under
“Registered Specialist Trade Contractors Scheme”
from January 2025 Onwards**

Hong Kong • 30 December 2024 – With effect from 1 January 2025, the “Truss-out Scaffolding” specifically for renovation and maintenance projects will be included as the 21st designated trade under the “Registered Specialist Trade Contractors Scheme” (the Scheme), to promote the professional development of that trade.

As one of the crucial supporting measures for “Construction 2.0” initiative in promoting professionalism of subcontractors, the Scheme has gained widespread recognition within the industry. The Scheme is now mandatory for all public works projects and construction projects under various public organisations, and support are received from developers and main contractors of private projects.

Since its launch by the Construction Industry Council (CIC) in 2019, the Scheme has expanded from the initial seven to now 21 designated trades. Through the comprehensive registration requirements on six core elements: safety, management, job experience, execution, finance and integrity management, the Scheme aims to unite and showcase a professional, capable, and responsible frontline team. Its regulatory regime uninterruptedly monitors and takes regulatory actions against registered companies involved in incidents such as construction safety. The dual approach enhances the professional standards, construction quality, and safety of the registered companies.
