### **Construction Industry Table Tennis Competition 2025** **Over 600 Players Compete in Intense Competitions**

**Hong Kong • 13 April 2025** – The Construction Industry Council (CIC) today held the Construction Industry Table Tennis Competition 2025 at Hong Kong Institute of Construction - Sheung Shui Campus. With Mr. Tony YAU, Director of Highways, as the Guest of Honour for the event, the competition saw over 600 players from 70 organisations participated in, concluding this annual event with resounding success. Additionally, two representatives from the Hong Kong, China Table Tennis Team were invited to perform an exhibition game and shared their experience with the participants.

The Construction Industry Table Tennis Competition was launched under the Construction Industry Sports and Volunteering Programme (CISVP) in 2017 and has been receiving overwhelming responses from the industry, players' skill levels have constantly elevated over the years. This year, players competed in Men's Singles in five categories (Workers Group, Master Group, Mature Group, Advanced Group and Youth Group), Women's Singles in three categories (Workers Group, Advanced Group and Youth Group) and Doubles in five categories (Men's Doubles, Women's Doubles, Mixed Doubles, Parent and Child Doubles, and Workers Doubles). Including both the preliminary round and the finals, over 450 matches took place in total, Hong Kong Institute of Construction Managers as the most decorated winner of the game, winning eight titles in total.

Adding to the excitements, Mr. Prince CHOY and Ms. SU Tsz-tung, representatives from the Hong Kong, China Table Tennis Team, played an exhibition game with the Mixed Doubles' champion, and shared their training experience with the participants. The fun-filled event featured not only hot competition but also a carnival with game booths and photo zones, allowing players and their families to enjoy a memorable weekend.

With the aim to bring care and warmth to the community, all sponsorship income and enrolment fee of the competition will be used for promoting volunteer services in the construction industry organised by CISVP. The CISVP strives to encourage a healthy lifestyle and instill a caring culture amongst industry practitioners.
