Ir Joseph LO, Head of Project Strategy and Governance Office of the Development Bureau (DEVB), and Ir Prof. Thomas HO, Chairman of the Construction Industry Council (CIC), joined hands to unveil these two significant events.

Today’s event also featured the launching of MiC / MiMEP Achievement Award 2025. The first MiC Achievement Award was successfully held in 2022, which recognised outstanding local projects, project teams, MiC advocators and practitioners for their contributions in the promotion and adoption of MiC. In recent years, MiMEP has been widely implemented in government buildings, public housing, and other construction projects, with its benefits on efficiency, quality, safety, and sustainability. This year, the CIC specially introduces the MiMEP Achievement Award to further encourage the application of MiC and MiMEP, establishing a standard of excellence in the industry.
