Construction Industry Council Graduation Ceremony 2016 Welcomes 4,700 new talents to join the construction industry

Hong Kong • 2 December 2016 – The Construction Industry Council (CIC) held the CIC Graduation Ceremony 2016 today at ZCB to congratulate and commend graduates for their hard work in completion of various courses and welcome them to the construction industry. The Ceremony also provided graduates an occasion to share their pride and happiness with family members and friends.

The Ceremony was officiated by Mr. Paul CHAN, Secretary for Development and Ir HON Chi-keung, Permanent Secretary for Development (Works) in the morning and afternoon sessions, respectively. About 600 people attended the Ceremony today, including graduates and their families, as well as guests from the construction industry.
