CIC Celebrates Graduation of Trainees

Over 600 people attended the Ceremony, including graduates, and their families, as well as guests from the construction industry.

For the training year 2014/2015, around 3,500 trainees completed the training courses provided by the Construction Industry Council, including Construction Supervisor / Technician Programme, Basic Craft Courses, and Short Courses. The graduates shared their pride and joy of becoming the newest construction professionals with family and friends at ZCB in the Ceremony officiated by Ir LEE Shing-see, Chairman of the CIC, and Ir Dr. Derrick PANG, Chairman of the Construction Industry Training Board of the CIC. Two guests-of-honour from the HKSAR Government were invited, namely, Mr. Donald TONG, Commissioner for Labour and Mr. Paul CHAN, Secretary for Development.
