A total of 491 industry practitioners participated.</p> <p>(c) Construction Industry Shoreline Clean-up Day: During all weekends in July 2021, the CISVP encourages industry stakeholders to organise volunteering activities which CISVP office has been providing assistance in coordination with related government departments. A total of 785 industry practitioners participated.</p>
