Exemption of Construction Workers Registration and Renewal Fees

Hong Kong · 26 September 2019 – In line with the support measures of The Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region to help enterprises and residents tide over the economic downturn, the Construction Industry Council (CIC) will waive the construction workers' registration and renewal fees for one year from 1 October 2019 to 30 September 2020 to relieve the burden of frontline construction workers.

In general, the registration or renewal fee of construction workers costs HK\$100 for a validity of five years. Workers can apply for the renewal of registration six months before the expiry of their current registration.
